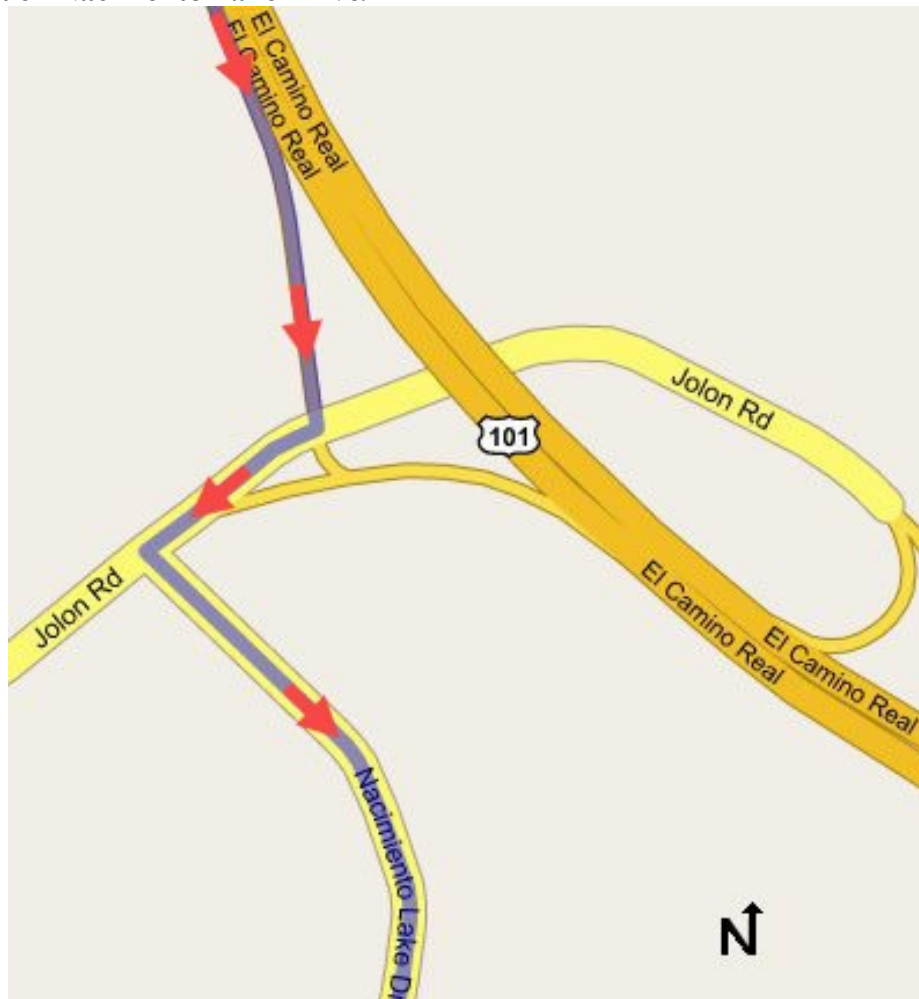




Driving Directions from the north

Driving directions to the Wildflower Triathlons from King City, Salinas, San Jose, San Francisco, Oakland, and Sacramento. Driving time is approximately 1 hour from King City.

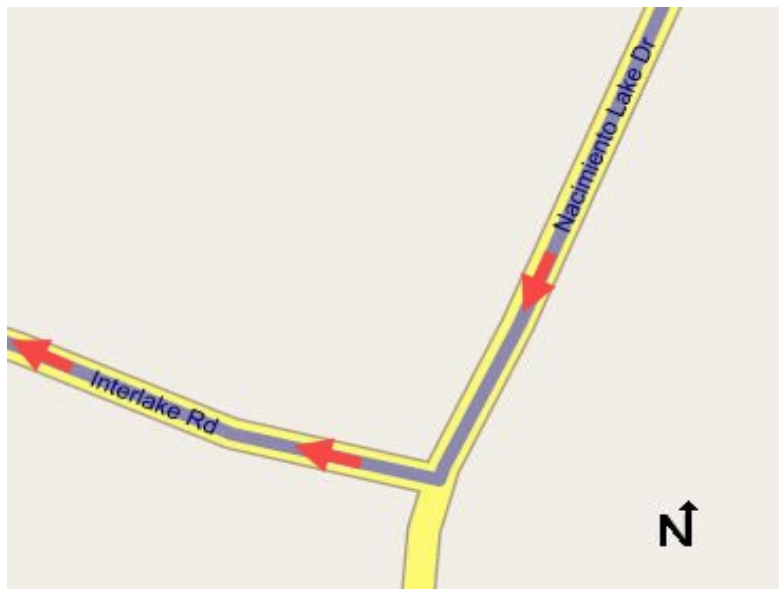
1. Drive **south** on **US101**. Pass through King City, and exit at **Jolon Road (Exit 252)** near Bradley. The exit is approximately 30mi south of King City, 75mi south of Salinas, and 135mi south of San Jose. **Do not** take the first Jolon Road exit immediately before King City; it is the same road but will take much longer to get to the event.
2. **Turn Right** at the stop sign at the bottom of the exit ramp. Follow Jolon Road for **0.1mi** and take a **left** on **Nacimiento Lake Drive**.



3. Follow Nacimiento Lake Drive for **8.7mi**. Pass over the Steel Bridge and travel up Nasty Grade. At the top of the hill take a right onto **Interlake Road**. Follow Interlake Road for **7.7mi**. You will travel along the ridgeline then down a big hill.

4. Turn right at **San Antonio Road**. This is the entrance to the park. Follow San Antonio Road for **3.0mi**. Pass through the **Front Gate**, go directly to the **Visitors Center**, and begin setting up your camping area. Welcome!
